Quilt Show Timeline

- All entry forms, including \$10 entry fee and color photo are due by March 5, 2011. Include your name and entry name on reverse of photo. Photos will not be returned. Make checks payable to Dixie Quilt Guild.
- All JUDGED entries, unless other shipping arrangements have been made, must be delivered from 5-7:00 PM, Wednesday, April 20 to the Dixie Convention Center, 1835 Convention Center Drive, St. George, Utah
- All NON-JUDGED entries, unless other shipping arrangements have been made, must be delivered from 1-4 pm, Thursday, April 21 to the Dixie Convention Center, 1835 Convention Center Drive, St. George, Utah
- All entries, unless other shipping arrangements have been made, must be picked up at the Dixie Convention Center from 6-7 pm on Saturday, April 23. You MUST have your receipt to pick up your entry and the information on your receipt must match the entry label sewn on the back
- If the entry is to be shipped, please enclose cost of return shipping with quilt. See below.
- NO EXCEPTIONS TO THESE RULES CAN BE ACCOMMODATED

Quilt Show Entry Guidelines and Procedures

- It is important that we receive all entry forms by the due date because the layout of the show is carefully planned from the information on the entry form. Please be realistic about what you can finish to avoid withdrawals.
- If it is determined that space is exceeded, the Dixie Quilt Guild reserves the right to return entries. You will be notified if your item is not accepted. We sincerely hope that all items will be displayed.
- All items must be quilted, made predominantly of fabric, finished, clean and in good condition. The only tied or denim quilts that will be accepted are those made by youth quilters or which are new crazy quilts. Tied heirloom quilts may be entered.
- Pre-quilted items and commercially quilted fabrics will not be accepted.
- Name and address on a piece of fabric must be sewn to the lower left side of the back of the item to be exhibited.
- Sleeves – Not necessary because of the way we hang quilts.
- If items are to be shipped, they must be shipped so that they arrive between April 12, 2011 and April 18, 2011. Shipped items should be sent to:

- All entries must be picked up between 6:00 and 7:00 pm the last day of the show. Entries that are not picked up will be taken home by quilt chairpersons. You will then have to arrange pickup at their convenience. Quilts to be returned by shipping must be received in a reusable, shipping container with a RETURN ADDRESS LABEL and PREPAYMENT OF RETURN SHIPPING AND INSURANCE enclosed. Please check the cost of shipping in advance since DQG cannot cover additional costs or refund overpayment. DQG assumes no responsibility for any damages or losses that may occur during shipping.
- One of the judges is NQA certified. The Dixie Quilt Guild reserves the right and allows the judges to change the category of any item. In case of any dispute related to the judging process, the judges' decision will be final. First, second and third place awards may be awarded in each category at the sole discretion of the judges. Each judge may present one Judge's Choice award from any category. A Best of Show will be awarded, as well as a Viewers' Choice. Prizes are as follows:
